- **Required:** Each submission must be accompanied with a *Vocations Poster Contest Entry Form - VPC 11/14A* attached to the back of each poster.
- **Deadline to submit to local councils:** **October 31, 2020. Local submissions are selected by sponsoring councils during the month of November.**
